#### LIFE\*SPIN Community Advocate

Depending on the situation, LIFE\*SPIN is still providing information, support and community-based programs to low-income Londoners through remote services.

Our Community Advocate, Leia, is continuing to assist clients to make application for disability supports, housing, pension benefits, and file Internal Reviews for individuals who have been denied disability benefits, discretionary assistance or Covid-19 emergency funds Also those who are seeking things like economical means for internet access, make sure you attend Leia's **upcoming workshops this month**. Knowledge is power .... and can truly help you!

We refer you to our website: <a href="www.lifespin.org">www.lifespin.org</a> or to our facebook page for any up-to-date information on income supports and resources that are available to help you through the difficult challenges you are struggling with. There is information on access to food, income supports, community resources, mental health supports and programs. We hope this information will help you find the supports you need.

<u>Utilities Support:</u> Through the Covid-19 Energy Assistance Program (CEAP), low-income customers can get direct support to pay bills for electricity and natural gas services. If you are behind on your bill and may have your service disconnected, you could qualify for on-bill credits of up to \$750 on overdue amounts occurred since March 17, 2020. If you have already received funding under this program (was \$500 in 2020), you may reapply based on overdue amounts still owing. You may qualify for the additional amount up the new maximum credit of \$750.https://www.oeb.ca/rates-and-your-bill/covid-19-energy-assistance-programs

<u>Value on Internet Providers:</u> make sure you sign up for the workshop in May to get the details on how to access low cost internet:

The Ontario Covid-19 Child Benefit provides financial support to families with young learners to help with additional costs during the COVID-19 pandemic. Starting on April 25, they will begin issueing payments of: \$400 for each child or youth up to Grade 12; and \$500 for each child or youth up to the age of 21 with special needs.

If you received a payment through the *Support for Learners* program, you do not need to apply for this additional payment. If you missed applying for the *Support for Learners* program, you will have the opportunity to apply. Applications will be open from May, 2021 to May 17, 2021.

You may qualify for a Canada Learning Bond of \$500, if you use part of this payment to open up a Registered Education Savings Plan (RESP) for your child. For more information: https://www.ontario.ca/page/get-ontario-covid-19-child-benefit If you already have an RESP for your child, you can still deposit a portion of the Covid-19 Child Benefit to the RESP and, depending on your net family income, you could receive an extra 20% on every dollar in your child's RESP each year with an additional 20% if you are low-income!!
