Advocates from several agencies and organizations will be on-site to assist you in requesting a Property Standards inspection. Repairs and issues include: missing screens, plumbing issues, electrical problems, repairs to roof or porches, flooring issues, smoke alarms, and other parts of your rental that need to be inspected.

The fair will also have a play area for children, refreshments and an opportunity to meet a Property Standards staff member.

Pocket Sized Farms: Day Camp for Kids ages 7-12

The LIFE*SPIN summer program for children has two components. During the week, we meet with campers on-line to read stories, do crafts and learning activities, and talk about the gardens we are growing. We provide the materials. On Fridays, we meet up at parks & natural areas with your whole family for fun activities.

Children enrolled and participating in the camp, will receive a home-based start-up food garden kit, and can pick up craft/learning kits for the following week at the weekly family outings. Each garden kit includes a garden shovel (unless you already received yours) or a trowel for container gardening if you live in an apartment building, sheep manure/compost, topsoil, vegetable seeds, plants and instructions on how to get started growing food at home.

Once registration closes, staff will contact you to confirm your name on our private Facebook group. We will book our first gathering for **Tuesday, July 2nd**, where you get to meet the leaders, pick up your craft kits and seed packages. Once you receive these, we will coordinate volunteers to drop-off plants and gardening materials to your home.

We have identified wonderful natural areas to explore in the city and will invite all members of your family to join us once each week. When you RSVP for each week, let us know how many people are coming from your family, so we can bring snacks for all and prepare your weekly craft kits for you to pick up at the following weekly outing.

Since 2020, On The Move Organics has worked in partnership with LIFE*SPIN to help aid local Londoners facing food insecurity.

Last year, 19,464 meals worth of fresh, local & organic food were delivered to families and individuals in need. We even dedicated several deliveries to seniors, since finding and shopping for fresh and affordable produce can be especially hard in the winter.

This year, we're planning an extension of the program, not only to serve more households, but also to utilize the program for community development in neighbourhoods that need it most.

Free Store

Our Free Store was created by low-income moms who had no local family members that could share hand-me-down items for their children. Today we provide clothes, bedding, toiletries, and small houseware items for adults and children of all ages. We only accept donations in excellent condition so shoppers can look & have the best we can offer. We aim to offer shoppers dignity, a meeting place and tangible support that improves their well-being.

Shopping Hours

Tuesdays: 10:00 AM - 2:00 PM

Wednesdays: 3:00 - 7:00 PM

Customers must register online once every calendar year whether you're a new or returning customer.

We continue to operate under Covid-19 guidelines. Customers can shop at the Free Store once a week, and we ask that only one person per household comes inside. Staff are tested weekly, and the store will close if we have positive cases. We'll provide you with a mask and hand sanitizer before entering. Don't forget to **bring your identification** when you shop!

Income Taxes

In 2023, we completed 374 returns, resulting in \$1,400,000 in direct benefits for those that applied.

If you need help filing your taxes, register for our Income Tax program! Assistance with filing previous tax returns up to 2013 is available now, and filing for 2023 will be available at the end of February.

Income taxes are done over the phone by appointment only. Appointment length depends on the number of taxes you need to file.

We are not able to assist with taxes for those who are self-employed, or for deceased individuals.

Advocacy

LIFE*SPIN's greatest contribution to London is the creation of a safe place for low-income citizens – families, our disabled, seniors, children and individuals – to find the help they need with a sense of dignity. For over 30 years, LIFE*SPIN has been the only organization in the London area that provides specialized assistance to ALL individuals in obtaining government benefits that they may be entitled to, such as provincial support and benefits. The critical needs in our community define the programs and services we offer.

In 2023, 9,724 families reached out for our help. The direct financial benefits to our clients resulting from our services during this year exceeds \$5,000,000.

Wrapping Up

Part of what keeps LIFE*SPIN unique and innovative is the foundation of personal experience, peer support and sense of caring for each individual who is courageous enough to reach out when they need a hand up.

Some things we noticed this year...

- Many more families are living together under the same roof to afford housing/heating costs.
- More seniors are struggling to keep their housing, especially when their spouse passes away.
- Parents trying to support children who have disabilities have a lot of difficulty accessing the support they need.
- Property standards by-laws are inadequately enforced in London. This leaves families in unsafe units that are not fit to live in just because the rents may be lower, even though the City has the power to fix them.

- The “homeless industry” in London has all but eliminated families with children as a priority, meaning longer waits for subsidized housing and programs to meet the increased housing needs.
